If your wines are stored at OWS, you may mail this form and payment to the school requesting a pick up. Please contact OWS and place a will call order with instructions that St. James staff is authorized for pick-up.

Unused bottles will be sold at the St. James School Wine Auction for the benefit of St. James School.

Wines in our possession will be stored in temperature controlled wine lockers courtesy of Oregon Wine Services.

On February 9, 2019 the McMinnville Wine and Food Classic will be holding its first annual Wine Maker's Dinner at the Evergreen Aviation Museum under the wings of the Spruce Goose. The Best of Show winery will be invited to pour their award winning wine as one of the featured wines at the dinner. A donation of 18 bottles of your Best of Show wines is required to participate in the event. If you decline to participate, the next highest scoring wine/winery will be invited as runner up.
